In 1894, Witzwil estate in Western Switzerland was turned into a prison. Prisoners had to work on the farm and dig irrigation ditches in the surrounding wetlands. From 1913, all Roma and Sinti entering Switzerland were interned. Families were split up and the men were sent to Witzwil to do hard labour until they and their families were deported.

### Did you know

... that in 1888 Switzerland became one of the first European countries to generally close its borders to Roma and Sinti?

... that Switzerland was also one of the first countries in Europe to create a national register of "Gypsies"? That was in 1911.
